SUMMARY STATEMENT: Oversees the Power Plant operation, including providing stand-by power as required.

DUTIES & RESPONSIBILITIES: Incumbent shall perform the following duties and responsibilities in accordance with Generally Accepted Industry and Professional Standards and the work requirements and performance specifications of the current Contract:

- Provides oversight to the Power Plant operation.
  - Ensures on camp power is available and uninterrupted while under the control of the Power Plant.
  - Ensures maintenance records are kept up to date.
  - Operates heavy equipment, vehicles and lifting equipment as required.
  - Performs major overhauls and rebuilds of remote site generator units.
  - Provide assistance and/or advice on generators, as required.
  - Performs complete incoming inspections on any assigned equipment, whether noted by operator or not, annotating any defects noted.
  - Upon completion of the Work Order ensures that all discrepancies have been accomplished and the Work Order is processed and brought to the Supervisor.
  - Ensures that all labor hours, parts, supplies, tools and equipment are correctly accounted for at all times.
  - Maintains all work and associated areas to a high level of cleanliness, safety and security.
  - Monitors the workload via an electronic database, including incoming, projected, on-going and awaiting parts and awaiting labor.
  - Ensures that all safety instructions are complied with and that all tools, machinery and equipment are correctly maintained and used and that safety gear is worn as appropriate.
  - Trains and directs Egyptian National staff in applicable areas of performance in accordance with Generally Accepted Industry and Professional Standards and the approved On-Job-Training Program.
  - Performs in Force Majeure situations in any capacity as designated.
  - Performs emergency and stand-by duties as required.
  - Performs other duties as required.
